Refer to the payment options on the second page and choose the option that suits your family budget, also note **5% discount** applies on tuition fee if the annual fee payment is made by **Friday 27 March 2026**. Should you wish to set up a direct debit from your bank account, the authority is included, so please complete and return to the school office (NB. Please include the date to commence payments).

Once your payment option is decided, complete the Payment Option Advice Form and return to the school office by Friday 13 March 2026.

Thanks to the generosity of schools like ours, Manaini joined training offered by Caritas Australia's local partner, FRIEND. Through the program, she learnt food processing skills to transform leftovers from crops into flour, improving her family's nutrition and increasing her weekly income to support her children's education. *"The project totally changed the life of my family and even the community,"* Manaini said.
