Loving God,

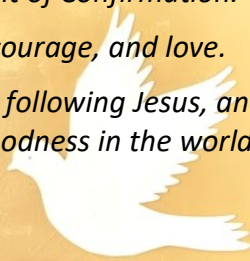
Pour out Your Holy Spirit upon our Year 6 students as they prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

UNIFORM REMINDER: A reminder that St Anne's now operates a year-round uniform policy. Students may wear either the summer or winter uniform, depending on weather conditions, ensuring comfort and practicality throughout the year.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION – SATURDAY, JUNE 6th: This Saturday evening, our Year Six students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation—an important milestone in their faith journey.

In preparation, students participated in a retreat yesterday and met with Father Tony Chiera, Vicar General of the Bunbury Catholic Diocese and Father Mars.

Confirmation is one of the seven sacraments of the Catholic Church. It is a sacred moment when baptised individuals receive the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in a deeper way, strengthening their commitment to live as followers of Jesus. It marks a stage where young people take greater responsibility for their faith and continue to grow in their relationship with God.

We ask our community to keep our Year Six students, their families, and sponsors in your prayers as they prepare for this special occasion. We look forward to celebrating with them.

KEEPING SAFE AT ST ANNE’S: At St Anne’s, we are committed to providing a safe and supportive environment for all students. As part of this commitment, we implement the *Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum (KS:CPC)*.

This evidence-based program teaches children how to:

- Recognise abuse
- Understand appropriate and inappropriate touching
- Seek help from trusted adults

The curriculum is delivered across all year levels and is aligned with the Australian Curriculum in Health and Physical Education. It is also integrated across other learning areas to ensure a comprehensive approach to child safety.

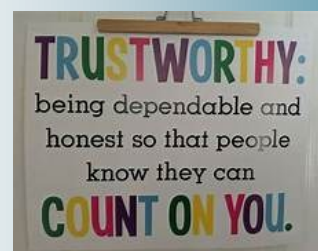

MJR AT ST ANNES:

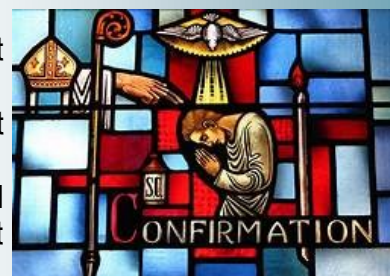


“Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit”
