Volunteers are always required to maintain the canteen open each week.



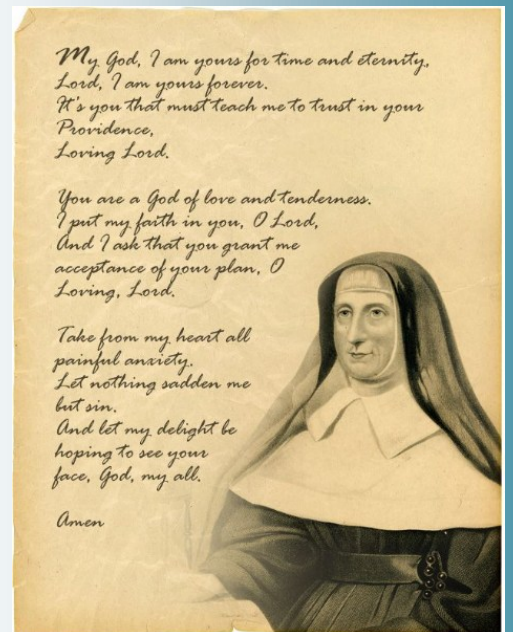
MJR AT ST ANNES:
